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A study on improving the oral health of Canadian seniors

Bruyère Village is participating in an important study of the oral health of Canadian seniors, and of ways to improve our oral health.

We are inviting volunteers to join this study.

There is no cost to join this study.

Volunteers will receive the following at no charge:

- » Up to 2 examinations of your teeth and gums by a dental hygienist
- » If you qualify, 4 quick applications of a clear medication to your teeth and gum line by a dental hygienist

These procedures are all topical and participants in previous studies and Canadian dental patients have reported no discomfort or pain with this treatment.

How much time will be involved to participate in this study?

Between 2 and 3 hours over the course of 10 weeks or so.

How safe is this medication applied to my teeth and gumline?

Very safe. It is approved by Health Canada and has been used by dentists and hygienists for many years.

Are there financial benefits from joining the study?

Participants will receive a special discount to continue on the medication if they wish.

Should I tell my dentist I am participating in this study?

What will I learn from participating in this study?

You will learn how bacteria cause poor oral health and how oral health is important to your overall health.
