



Would you like to take part in a research study?

There is an association between raised BMI and female urinary symptoms. The WUP's (Weight loss, Urogynaecological Symptoms, Psychological Changes) research study will help us to identify and track the association as weight loss occurs.

What does the Trial involve?

- Online Questionnaires at intervals over prior to your bariatric surgery and of 18 months after.
- Optional vaginal examinations at these intervals
- Optional psychological interviews at intervals

Do I qualify to enter the trial?

Yes if you can say yes to all of the following:

- **Female** Participants
- Qualify for **Bariatric Surgery**
- **Age 18** or over
- No Severe mental health problems.
