(FOR PEOPLE WITH DIFFICULTY UNDERSTANDING)**

Impact evaluation of the STAR+ skills development programme in Bangladesh

What? We are talking people who have different kinds of disabilities about work. We want to know about the job you are doing. If you don't work, we want to ask you how you feel about that. We may ask you other questions too, such as about what activities you do at home and in your neighbourhood.

Do I have to take part? No. It is up to you to decide whether or not to take part. You don't have to answer the questions if you don't want to. You can also stop me at any time if you don't want to continue.

Keeping the information private and safe. [Qualitative: We will be recording and writing up everything you tell us and what the other people in the study tell us.] We will not share your name or any other information that could be used to identify you with anyone outside this research team.

Why are we doing this? We will use this information to help plan to make better services and programmes for people with disabilities so that they can work if they want to.

What do I have to do? I will talk to you for about 30 minutes to 1 hour. [Qualitative only: If you agree I will make a recording of what we say.]
