

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN THE RESEARCH PROJECT ACCORDING TO THE ARTICLE 13 OF THE REGULATION UE 2016/679

According to Article 13 of the Regulation UE 2016/679 (“GDPR”), on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/CE, and according to D. lgs. n. 196/2003 (as amended by D. lgs. n. 101/2018), the University of Milan informs you of how your personal data will be processed in the context of the research entitled “*An in vivo pilot study on permanence in saliva of two different probiotics strain administered through chewing gums*”.

Purpose, type of data and legal basis of the processing.

For the purposes of the research explained in the information sheet, the investigator will have to process some personal data and special categories of personal data, such as initials of name and surname, date of birth, gender, biological samples (saliva samples).

The mentioned data will be processed only for this research.

The legal basis for the processing is consent to the processing of personal data according to Article 6 c. 1 lett. A) of Reg. UE 2016/679. You can withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data at any time by sending an email to dpo@unimi.it or to the scientific contact person of the project. In this case, it will be impossible for her to continue participating in the research project.

Methods of processing and storage of personal data

The data collected will be processed in compliance with the principles of relevance, completeness and non-excessiveness in relation to the purposes for which they are processed, also with the aid of IT and telematic tools suitable for storing and managing the data, and, in any case, in such a way as to guarantee their security and protect the utmost confidentiality of the data subject.

The data will be stored in pseudo-anonymised form. In this case, the possibility of knowing the identity of the subject is reserved to the scientific contact person of the research.

The data will be stored for 5 years

Personal data will not be disseminated.

The data *will not be* transferred to third countries or international organizations

The data will be published in scientific journals, presented at conferences in anonymous and aggregated form.

Categories of persons authorised to process and transfer data

The data will be processed by the scientific referent of the project and by the research group (*Prof.ssa Maria Grazia Cagetti, Dott.ssa Silvia Cirio, Dott.ssa Claudia Salerno, Prof. Guglielmo Campus, Prof. Simone Domenico Guglielmetti, Dott. Valerio Mezzasalma, Dott. Andrea Sarrica, Dott.ssa Natalja Kirika*).

The data *will not be* transferred to third parties either during or at the end of the research.

Exercising rights

According to the Articles 15-22 of RGPD you have the right to request access to your personal data, the right to request the rectification or deletion of the same, the right to request the limitation of processing, the right to object to processing, the right to request data portability, by contacting the Data Controller also through the Data Protection Officer by writing an e-mail to dpo@unimi.it or to the scientific contact person of the project by writing an e-mail to *maria.cagetti@unimi.it*.

The right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority or a judicial authority.

If you believe that the processing of your personal data is in violation of the provisions of the Regulation, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor as provided for by art. 77 of the same Regulation or to appeal to the appropriate judicial venues according to Article 79 of the Regulation.
