Dear Sir/Madam,

We are offering your child the opportunity to take part in a research project entitled "Evaluation of a preventive action on food choices based on a game simulating a virtual supermarket, Epidaure Market 2". Before making your decision to take part in this project, we ask you to read this letter. You are free to accept or refuse your child's participation in this research. You may withdraw your consent at any time without any consequences for you or your child (no liability or prejudice).

Study objective: To evaluate the effectiveness of the prevention program that will be offered to your child as part of his or her education in science and life of the earth.

Study procedure: Your child's participation will require 3 50-minute sessions (in class), one taking place before and two after the intervention (1 and 5/6 months) in order to observe the effects of the intervention on their knowledge and motivations around food.

Your child may be asked to take part in group discussion sessions to understand the motivations behind or obstacles to changes in the purchasing and consumption behaviors of young people and their families. Participation in these sessions is optional.

If you agree to your child's participation in the study, we may also ask you, as the parent of a pupil who has taken part in the Epidaure Market intervention, to take part in a telephone interview. You are free to decide whether or not to take part in this interview, without this affecting your child's participation in the study.

Participation consists of answering various questionnaires on knowledge, representations and motivations around food choices.

Dissemination of research results: The results of the research will be communicated to the participating schools, which will then be able to pass them on to you.

Confidentiality of your personal data: In the context of the research which is the subject of this newsletter and in which we are proposing that your child take part, your personal data will be processed to enable us to analyze the results of the research in the light of its objective. Only the data required for the research will be collected. Under conditions that ensure confidentiality, these data will be transmitted to the researcher in charge of the research. These data will be anonymized by a unique participant code. The link between your child's name and this code will be kept in a secure place so that this data can be deleted if requested. This data will be managed and stored in accordance with current regulations. In accordance with the provisions of the RGPD and the law relating to data processing, data files and individual liberties, you have a right of access and rectification.

Consent to participate in the study

Mr. Florian Lecêtre, doctoral student at the University of Montpellier, offers your child the opportunity to take part in a research project organized by the Epsilon laboratory under the supervision of Prof. Florence Cousson-Gélie. You are free to accept or refuse your child's participation in this research, without any prejudice to your child. As a parent, you are free to accept or refuse to take part in the telephone interview you may be offered, without any prejudice to you.

To help you make your decision, we have provided you with an explanation of the objectives and procedures of this research.

This research will be conducted within the framework of current French legislation. It was discussed in advance by the Ethics Committee of Paul Valéry Montpellier 3 University on (04/09/23).

You may withdraw your consent at any time, without having to justify this decision and without any prejudice.

If you do not agree with your child's participation in this study, you may return the form. If you do not return the form, if your child agrees, he or she will take part in the study.

The right of access provided for by the RGPD and the "informatique et liberté" law may be exercised at any time with the study managers. You will be able to exercise your right to withdraw your data with them.

In the event of publication of the results in a scientific journal, neither your identity nor that of your child will be revealed. The data collected as part of the research will be anonymized.
