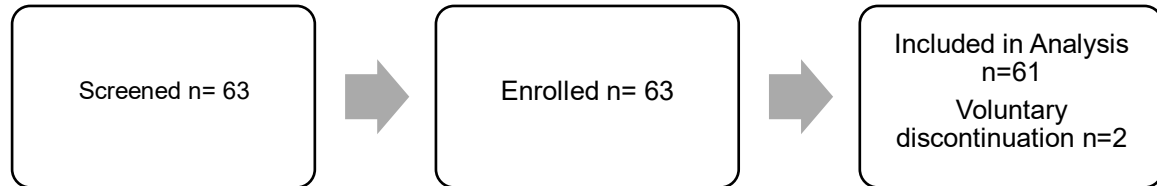


## Study Title: Clinical Acceptance and Performance of Hercules soft contact lenses
