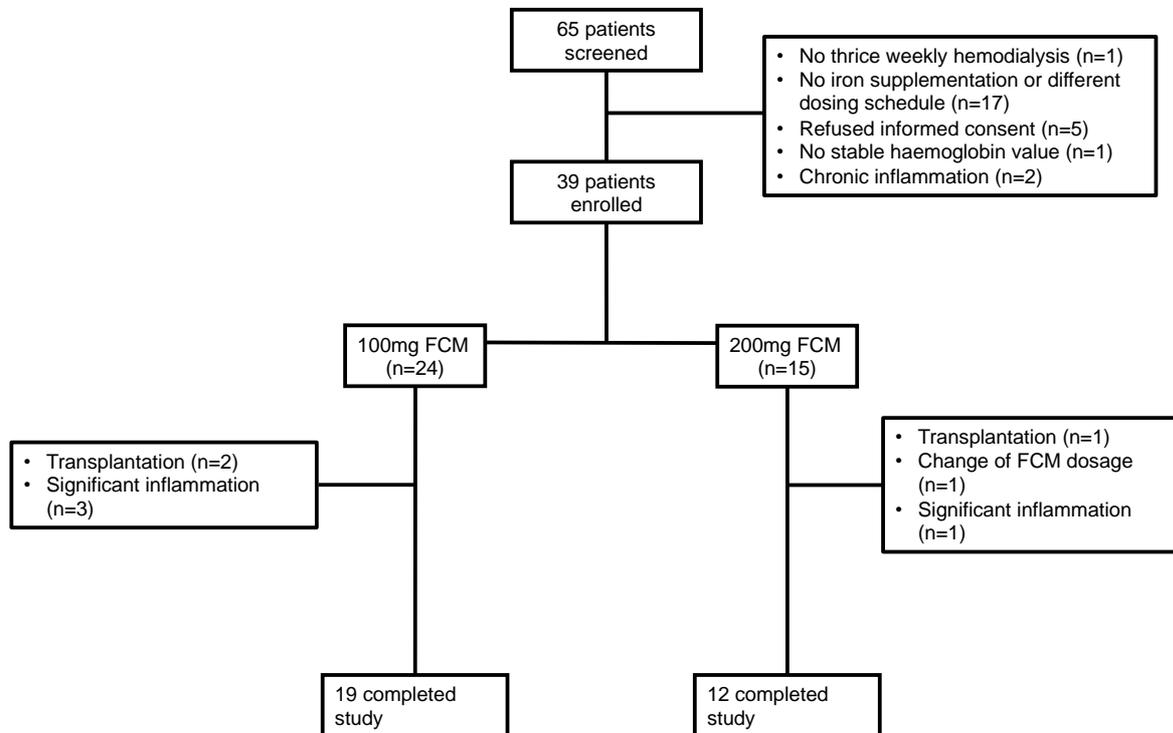


Basic Results

Outcome Measures

Ferritin values increased by $113 \pm 72.2 \mu\text{g/l}$ ($P < 0.001$) from baseline to the peak value and remained significantly elevated until two weeks after the administration of 100mg FCM ($n = 19$). After the administration of 200mg FCM ($n = 12$), ferritin values increased by $188.5 \pm 67.56 \mu\text{g/l}$ ($P < 0.001$) and remained significantly elevated by the end of week three. TSAT values increased by $12.0 \pm 9.7 \%$ ($P < 0.001$) and $23.1 \pm 20.4 \%$ ($P = 0.002$) in patients receiving 100 or 200mg FCM, respectively, and returned to baseline within four days.

Serious Adverse Events

No serious adverse events were recorded during the study.
