Information and informed consent notice for adolescents participating in the Epidaure Market 2 evaluation

Today, we're inviting you to take part in the Epidaure Market 2 evaluation. Before you decide whether or not to take part, we'd like to give you some important information.

What's involved?

As part of your life and earth sciences course, you'll be doing some activities around food. This work will be done with a game in which you can shop in a virtual store.

The study?

The study we're asking you to take part in will enable us to find out whether these activities are suitable and effective for young people of your age. Your answers and opinions are very important to us.

What do I have to do?

All you have to do is answer questions on the computer and on paper for about 50 minutes. These questions will cover your motivations, habits and perceptions about food and your food choices.

After 3 sessions of activities with your science teacher, we'll ask you to answer these questions again under the same conditions.
