Title of research project: Art therapy research project in a long-term institution for the mentally ill (Marienheim in Peiting) as part of a doctorate at University of Augsburg, Institute for Art Education.

Description: This paper addresses the question of whether therapist-guided imagery can improve communication skills in patients with chronic schizophrenia and how this is at least partially reflected in features of language when therapy progresses positively.
